Burglary of a store possession of stolen property/Arrest

Sunday October 14th, 2007 seven-hundred block Stanyan

Park Station Officers responded to a call of a person climbing into the broken window of bike store. The callers were passing by and saw the suspect so they went to the business next door and ask that the police are called. When Officers arrived they observed the suspect in front of the store trying to reassemble the bike he had just stolen. A quick arrest was made and the two witnesses stayed around to give statements. Also found on the suspect was a large sum of cash he removed from the store and the items he spent time shopping for.

Marijuana, Possession for Sales

Tuesday, October 16th, 2007, Alvord Lake Area

I know that you will find this as unbelievable as I do, but there was a 35 year old white male arrested at the entrance to the Park by Alvord Lake. Plainclothes officers observed him in several short conversations with persons entering and leaving, and then try to hide his face from them. They went to detain him, and when he fled they grabbed him. When the officers grabbed his jacket, they felt several baggies of suspected marijuana. A warrant check and search were conducted, followed by an arrest and booking.

Methamphetamine /Possession of Narcotics Paraphernalia

Thursday, October 18, 2007,3:41a.m. 1400 Block McAllister

Officers from Park Station responded to an elderly care facility where the night caretaker was viewing through a security camera 2 men trying to open the front door. Being that it was early in the morning the caretaker assumed that these 2 men were not visiting a resident so he contacted the police. Upon their arrival the officers located 2 men fitting the description standing a block away. Once detained the officers did a quick search of the suspects for possible weapons. The search revealed a long glass pipe used for smoking Methamphetamine on one of the males. A more thorough search of the male revealed a small black bag with a baggie of suspected

Methamphetamine inside of it. After a check of the perimeter of the care facility was made it was determined that the suspects did not enter the premise. One of the males was released at the scene the other was booked.

Dog Bite

Thursday, 10/18/07, 12:30 pm; Lower Terrace

2 Pitt-Bull dogs got out of their home and bit a man walking down the street. Animal Care and Control responded and did the investigation.

Theft from a person aboard a Muni bus

Thursday, 10/18/07, 2pm; at Geary & Divisadero

A juvenile male snatched a handheld video game system from a man on the MUNI bus. He gave chase and followed the youth from a distance while calling the police. The officers responded quickly and were able to apprehend the youth. Unfortunately, he ditched the video game before he was nabbed.

Stay Away Order Violation

Friday, October 19, 2007, 1:48a.m. 1900 block Golden Gate

Officers from Park Station responded to a call of a restraining order violation. Officers were familiar with this location because of numerous prior calls regarding the same suspect. Officers knew that a 90 year old mother was calling about her drug addicted daughter who had managed to enter the mother's home to sleep after a month of abusing drugs and alcohol. Officers were able to locate the daughter in one of the bedrooms and could see that she was intoxicated and possibly under the influence of some sort of narcotics. The courts had granted a restraining order keeping the daughter away from her elderly mother but unfortunately the daughter refuses to obey it. Officer from Park Station have responded out to the mother's home several times to assist her with her daughter and even have arrested the daughter numerous times for violating the restraining order but she keeps getting released the next day. So, the officers, seeing that the daughter had indeed violated the order **again**, arrested her yet **again**. Hopefully, the revolving door of criminal justice will stop soon.

Vandalism
