(7:30-7:50) Preston Kilgore

- Jen Schneider has left, Preston Kilgore now going to be the new point of contact for NOPNA moving forward.
- Vaccination rate is 75% in SF with restrictions loosening
- Slow Streets: Looking to make Page a slow street permanently. Rally at Grove & Van Ness for keeping/maintain bus lines.
- Intersection at McAllister & Lyon: Went from 4 stop signs to 2 to speed up bus lines. We're seeing this become increasingly dangerous due to slow streets on Lyon. Preston has a variety of data/updates sending to group after today's meeting

- **Fell Street Road Diet:** Removed one lane of traffic (4->3) on Fell street and make way for the westbound Bike Lane. sWith extra space, we've created a bike lane that has been instrumental in easing congestion along the Panhandle.
- **Turk Blvd:** Underwent efforts to calm street traffic patterns. Put posts in the center lane to prevent speeding, etc. (well received).
- Golden Gate Ave Slow Street: Since the slow street implementation (16 months), we've had zero crashes/collisions. SF Day School using Slow street for outdoor recreation. GG is permanent, but SFMTA is still developing what that looks like.
- Biggest feedback SFMTA collected is disobeying traffic laws
- 62% survey response in favor of west of Masonic GG Slow street; 54% in favor of Broderick/Divis Extensions
